Chapman Avenue Noise Study is in.

At the direction of the City Council, the Public Works Department has performed a traffic noise measurement study of residential properties along Chapman Avenue from Cannon Street to Newport Boulevard. The study was performed in three segments, each having distinctly different terrain, and identifies causes of noise, characteristics of noise, effectiveness of noise attenuation, and areas of potential noise attenuation. Excerpts from the summary are quoted below.

Traffic noise measurements have been conducted to quantify the existing noise levels along Chapman Avenue between Newport Boulevard and Equestrian Drive. First and second row residences along both sides of the roadway were monitored during the survey. The measurement results indicated that residences located within the Broadmoor, Pheasant Run, and Chandler Ranch Communities experience traffic noise levels that are in compliance with the City of Orange's Exterior Noise Guideline of 65 dBA.

Exterior to Interior Noise Reduction tests were conducted at representative residences located in the Broadmoor, Pheasant Run, High Horse Trail, and Chandler Ranch Communities. All existing and future interior noise levels comply with the State of California's In-

terior Noise Standard of 45 dBA CNEL.

Motorcycle noise measurements were conducted during a weekend at two residences that border Chapman Avenue. The measurement data showed that the majority of motorcycle pass-by noise levels were within the State of California's Vehicle Noise Code limit of 86 dBA at 50 feet. However, occasional motorcycles with altered exhaust systems did exceed the State noise limit. Because of the intrusive nature of the motorcycle noise, it can be a significant source of annoyance to residents that live along Chapman Avenue.
